

INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES 2020-2021


Carrollton City Schools Nutrition Program serves locally grown items, fresh fruit and vegetables, low fat and whole grains daily.

At the beginning of the school year, each student and staff member will be issued a personal identification number. This number will enable students and staff to pay for their meals by the day, week, month, or year. Students finding themselves without meal money may charge their meals up to an amount equivalent to \$10.50 per paid student, \$2.10 for reduced, and no charges allowed for free eligible students. The student will receive a charge slip showing their account balance and parents will be notified when account balances are low. If the meal charge limit is exceeded, no further charges will be allowed. Meal accounts may be maintained by depositing cash, checks or online payments through www.ezschoolpay.com.
