Student achievement on End of Grade and End of Course Milestones English Language Arts assessments will increase by 3% in the combined proficient and distinguished levels.

SCHOOL GOALS 2019-2020

The goals for Carrollton Elementary are aligned with our system goals and expectations for school improvement.

Teachers and students will focus on improving literacy skills of all students.

- Increase the percentage of K students achieving a STAR Early Literacy score equal to or greater than 600
- Increase percentage of students in 1st grade achieving a lexile score at or above 300 according to STAR assessment
- Increase percentage of students in 2nd grade achieving a lexile score at or above 500 according to STAR assessment
- Increase 3rd grade student achievement on the End of Grade Milestones ELA assessment by 3% in the combined proficient and distinguished levels

At School

As a school, we will...

- Provide high quality curriculum and instruction and ongoing support to ensure that all students master grade level standards.
- Implement Guided Reading groups a minimum of 4 days per week.
- Include POTD (Problem of the Day) to support literacy in Math content.
- Provide all students with balanced literacy instruction in a literacy- rich learning environment.
- Provide parents with frequent reports through newsletters, conferences, emails, and/or phone calls regarding student progress.
- Present parents with grade level expectations and resources to help their child succeed.

At Home

As a parent, I will...

- Partner with teachers to support academic learning goals for my child.
- Ensure that my child reads and works on sight words and math facts at least 3 times per week.
- Communicate regularly with the teacher via the agenda, email, or phone, or conference.
- Attend parent nights provided by CES to assist me in helping my child at home.
- Attend each scheduled conference to discuss the academic and behavioral progress of my child.

Student Responsibilities

Carrollton Elementary School students will work to reach their highest potential by:

- Actively participating in class activities and asking questions when I do not understand
- Reading, on or above my lexile level, independently or with a family member, at least 3 times per week.
- Using skills I learn to be a proactive problem solver and critical thinker
- Practicing listening, speaking, and writing to share my ideas
